



**Quilter's Alphabet**  
**Block of the Month**  
**First Month**

**Fabric Requirements:**

3/8 yd. Each of 15 Colors

Blue Sashing & Borders: 2 1/4 yds.

Red Border: 1 1/4 Yds.

The wall hanging measures 40" x 47" and consists of 30 – 6" Blocks.

The first block in this series is the *Attic Window* – a 6" block.

**Cutting Instructions:**

*Dark Blue:* Cut 1 – 4 1/2" Square

*Red:* Cut 1 – 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Rectangle

*Dark Red:* Cut 1 – 2 1/2" Square, Mark Once on the Diagonal

Cut 1 – 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Rectangle

**Assembly:**



Using the *quick corner* method, place (right sides together) the Dark Red 2 1/2" Square on the Red Rectangle and stitch along the mark you made on the diagonal. Be sure to place the mark properly to match the block diagram below. Trim 1/4" from that line and fold back and press. We will refer to this method in future blocks as the *quick corner* method.

Following diagram shown, sew in order. Use Moon Drawing as an appliqué template.
