



Row By Row/Month By Month
Block of the Month Mystery
January

This quilt measures finished 48" x 64". It consists of 12 rows of different sized blocks—one row for each month. Assembly and borders will be Clue 13. You will be making the specified number of blocks each month as directed. Enjoy!

Fabric Requirements: *Cream Background:* 2 yds; *Scraps for blocks:* Reds, blues, greens, yellows, purples; *Inside Borders:* 1/2 yd each green and light green. *Binding:* 1/2 Yd Green

The January block in this series is the *Snowflake* block. You will need to MAKE 9.

Cutting Instructions:

Background: Cut 2 – 2 7/8" Squares, Cut once on the diagonal

White: Cut 1 – 3 1/4" Square, Cut twice on the diagonals

 Cut 2 – 1 7/8" Squares, Cut once on the diagonal

Blue: Cut 1 – 2 1/4" Square, Cut twice on the diagonals

Lt. Blue: Cut 1 – 2 1/4" Square, Cut twice on the diagonals

Assembly:

Following diagram, join the center 4 units as shown. Your center unit should measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2". Add 4 white triangles as shown. Then add background triangles as shown. Your finished block should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". Make 9. Join to form the first row as shown.
